EXAM CHARGES

ABSENCES

Exam fees as charged to us by the Exam Boards, will be rechargeable to the student, should a candidate fail to attend an examination without good reason and without informing the school. Misreading the exam timetable or taking a family holiday will not be accepted as a satisfactory explanation of absence. If a valid doctor's note/medical certificate was made available at the time of absence, exam fees will be waived.

ATTENDANCE

If attendance falls below 90% for the period prior to the exam season without good reason eg. serious accident/illness, the school reserves the right to charge the student for the examination fees.


RESITS

All re-sit requests are chargeable to the student with the exception of the following circumstances:

- the candidate was absent due to sickness and produced a medical note
- if there was a major disturbance such as a fire alarm, during the first sitting
- The school is entering you for a re-sit as you have not achieved a Level 4 or above in Maths, English Language or English Literature- in this circumstance, the school will fund your English Language entry.

Re-sit entries will only be made once the appropriate fee has been paid via the school ParentPay system (see below).

Step 1: Log into ParentPay and select Exam Fees optional-click on "view details and pay".



Step 2: Add correct amount into "how much would you like to pay". Please cross-reference the re-sit form as fees do differ for each exam Board. Please also add the code into the "add notes" so these can be cross referenced (eg. 1MA1H). These can be found on the students results slip or check with the teacher or Mrs Mundy if unsure.



EXTERNAL CANDIDATES

Ex-students can be entered at Farmor's for re-sits. Teacher signature is not required overleaf. The school does not accept private candidates. Payment should be made via BACs transfer to the Farmor's Account: Sort code 308095, Account number 32698360. Please add EXAMS and surname as the reference

Once payment has been completed, forms should be returned to the Exams Office by the candidate for entry by Mrs Mundy before the deadline.
