

Parent Bulletin Week Commencing 11th May (Week A)

(Amended, two of the safeguarding links were not working in the original version sent Friday 8th May)

The school closure has brought changes to our routines that have been communicated home in letters from Mr Evans over the course of the last 6 weeks. Please check this summary to ensure you are familiar with all of these changes:

- All work is set on Show My Homework with a due date of Sunday to help students manage their workload during the week. All year groups are now working on a changed and/or reduced timetable, Year 9 starting from this Monday 11th May. More information here

- Students should aim to complete between 3 and 5 hours of work per day if possible, ideally during school hours. It is fine to not complete all the tasks set if they have reached 5 hours or can't access the tasks.
- Teachers will not be conducting live lessons over the internet, more details here
- Most trips and other activities planned up to July have been cancelled, finance information for this is here
- Should your circumstances change, and you think you are in need of free school meals see here
- School is closed for all students except children of key workers or vulnerable students. If your circumstances have changed and you now meet this criteria please contact admin@farmors.gloucs.sch.uk
- We are unable to open school for any other students to collect books or equipment, should your child need new books or paper to complete their Show My Homework tasks these will need to be purchased from your supermarket during your regular grocery shop.

- All Years: Tutors are setting a short 1 minute weekly check-in survey on Show My Homework through their PSHCE lesson. It's important that all students complete this so we can gauge how they are accessing the work set. Please check that your child completes this before Wednesday evening.
- All Years: Each month the school office will be sending out regular test emails, parents do not need to reply, it's for the office to pick up from our end any undelivered emails to student contacts.
- All Years: The annual parent's survey will close on Wednesday 13th May. Please do complete it if you have not done so already.
