Notices:

- All Years: Please continue to check that your child has completed their weekly tutor check-in survey by Wednesday; this has proved to be a good way for students to report any issues to their tutors. Previous weeks tell us that the average student is mostly spending between 3 and 4 hours per day on their school work, with Year 10s spending between 4 and 5 hours per day. About two thirds of students rate their ability to access the work set as 4 or 5 out of 5. The mean average across all year groups is 3.8 out of 5.
