#### **Sixth Form Admission**

The majority of sixth form interviews have now been completed and I will be sending out offer letters (stating the subjects they have been offered) in the next few weeks. These will be addressed to the students and posted to their home address. The offers are conditional at this stage, pending GCSE results. If your son or daughter has applied to study a subject but does not have the predicted grade then their offer will not include this subject; we will have discussed an alternative subject which will be included in the offer. If they achieve the required result for the subject they originally wanted then we can give a revised offer on results day. This has been detailed in their Discussion Record at interview and can be accessed by all the enrolling staff on the day.
