

CERN TRIP: Geneva, Switzerland
Tuesday 12th December – Thursday 14th December

Dear Parent

I am delighted to confirm that your son/daughter has expressed a wish to attend the CERN residential trip and is able to attend. Thank you for your deposit to secure his/her place. I can confirm that flights and accommodation have been booked. Please see attached brochure for your safe keeping. This includes full emergency contact details, flight times and programme for the trip. Students will have a meeting at school which covers the important aspects of the trip. Please be aware that students will need to come as normal to school to leave on the 12th December at 9.15 after registration.

Accommodation details

Accommodation is at the Hotel de Geneve in the centre of Geneva a few minutes walk from the main railway station. Accommodation is in triple or twin rooms.

Arrangements have been made for a CERN trip Swiss supper on the Friday night after the CERN tour at the Edelweiss hotel and restaurant.

All meals and snacks are provided. Students need only bring a small amount of money for souvenir purchases and additional drinks or snacks.

I would like to remind you that the final payment for the trip is due by 3rd December (Payment due £240). Thank you those who have already made full payment.

All monies accepted are non-returnable, unless of course we manage to sell the trip to someone else. It is also a condition of travel that all pupils are current members of school and should this status change between now and the date of departure, they will forfeit the right to travel and again refunds can only be made in the event that another member of the school takes up the place.

Please could you ensure that your daughter has a valid European Health Insurance Card (commonly known as 'EHIC'). The card entitles the holder to state-funded (sometimes free) medical care, where it is deemed medically necessary, whilst they are temporarily located in any EEA (European Economic Area) country.
