Principles

- If you have an afternoon exam, you will spend the hour before with subject specialist staff.
- Reduce anxiety
- Build confidence
- Check you know where you're going and what you're doing.
- Get in the right 'head space'.

Principles 2

If you have a morning exam, you have a subject specific session the day before

General Revision Sessions When you have chosen these, remember to bring revision materials with you.

What if your exam finishes at 10.50am?

- If your exam finishes in period 2 but before break, go to the canteen.
- You get early access to the food ©
- Do not wander the site.
- There are lots of other exams going on (including in the finance house) not just yours.

Are you ready?

- On Tuesday 7th have all your equipment ready for a tutor check in the morning.
- Check it this weekend and buy what you need.

Exams Reminder

- Morning exams: start at 9.05am
- Afternoon exams start at 1.20pm.

Be at the exam room ten minutes before

- Registration as usual in the morning at 8.45am (8th -23rd May)
- Check lunch times from Thursday 9th May lunch is after period 3: 12.35- 1.15pm (Monday times stay the same.)

Study sessions 8th – 23rd May

- Registers will be taken.
- If you need to leave school, sign out in Student Services as usual.

After Half Term

Come in only for your exams – no need to sign in and out

- Come in for exams and study as well in your chosen sessions.
- Designated study rooms until the last exam.
- Sign in and out at Student Services

Exam Rooms and Rules

Sports Centre – bags stored in changing rooms;
line up in the car park

• BS1 /BS2 / PS1 /SO1 – bags stored in foyer lockers; line up on entrance ramp.

- Ensure phones are switched off and in your bag.
- No watches of any kind
- Check you have the right equipment
- Make sure you check the Monday afternoon exam end times and if you need a lift home.

All Rooms

- Check your personal timetable
- Check your emails regularly in case of rooms changes
- If unsure, ask in advance.
- Clash candidates have had a separate letter with all information – especially to bring lunch!

What do you wear?

Problems

• Illness –

Let Student Services know if you are ill on the day of an exam.

Let the invigilators know if you are feeling ill during an exam.

Lateness –

If you are running late let Student Services know If you are too late, you may not be able to enter the exam

Special Consideration

- If there is a reason why you might be disadvantaged then let us know. This could be being unwell, an event at home, or anything that impacts you.
- If you're not sure, come and talk to Mr Salvidge or Mrs Mundy or your tutor or me.
- You may get some allowance from exam boards (2-5%)

Results Day

- Thursday 22nd August
- LRC open from 9am to midday: Collect results, enrol in Sixth Form, come and celebrate with friends.
- If you know you are going to be away, let Mrs Mundy know in advance to arrange for your results to be emailed to you.
- Certificates will not come until November/December and your parents will be emailed to arrange for you to come and collect them.

Appeals

- If you are unhappy with your results, there will be an appeals process. It is important that you come in to discuss this and get any relevant forms on the day.

- Grades can go down as well as up.
- Very few grades change in this process each year, so make the most of being prepared and doing your best.
