

16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

We have been allocated **£2,423** by ESFA to support our 220 Sixth Form students, particularly prioritising those who are disadvantaged.

The guidance for the allocation of this funding stipulates that we should provide new provision with this allocation which would support students with the difficulties experienced through the Covid Pandemic.

We have put this funding allocation towards the following provision:

1. We have increased the hours that Liz Lloyd, Careers Lead, works so she can meet one-to-one with students to support destinations for all students. This supports a key priority in ensuring all students are supported to the next phase of the education or employment at the end of their studies with us.
2. We have increased our pastoral provision in the Sixth Form with a Head of Y12 and a Head of Y13, so there is more capacity for pastoral and academic support for students to overcome barriers to accessing the remote learning as well as mental health support.
3. We have supported individual students with ICT support and resources to facilitate independent study.
4. We will be offering Sixth Form students tutoring to support confidence and progression to secure destination progression.
5. During lock-down, we are offering individual support and resources to vulnerable and disadvantaged students, triaged by the pastoral support outlined above.

The measures we have put in place offer support to all students in our post-16 provision. Disadvantage and the impact of lost learning is varied and can change over the course of the pandemic, so our resources are flexible enough to adjust to those changing circumstances and ensure no one is without support if they need it or ask to access it.

The support we have put in place costs in excess of the allocation.
