FARMOR'S ENDOWED FOUNDATION TRUST

Farmor's Endowed Foundation Trust (F.E.F.T.) provide grants to students who have attended either Farmor's Secondary School or Fairford Primary School for at least two years during their school life. Grants can be sought to support:

- payment towards further education
- purchase of clothing, tools, books etc to prepare for or to enter a profession, trade or calling, e.g. an apprenticeship
- travel for educational purposes
- study of music or the arts

For an application to be considered, the applicant must **be under the age of 25 at the date of the** grant being made; and must be attending or have attended either Farmor's School or Fairford Primary School for at least two years during their schooling and be in need of financial assistance. Applicants must not have previously received a grant from the F.E.F.T.

The grant applications are not means tested, but the applications must be made directly to Farmor's School who will use their knowledge of the students to ensure that recommendations made to F.E.F.T. for grants are within the remit of the grant provision.

Applicants should write a letter of application outlining the reason for their application and how the grant will be used if they are successful.

Applications are reviewed by the Assistant Head, Sixth Form, School Business Manager and a F.E.F.T. Trustee, who make their recommendations for awards to the Trustees of Farmor's Endowed Trust on an anonymous basis.

All applications must be received by **the last school day prior to October half term each year**. Applicants will be informed whether their application has been successful **by the end of November**. If the application is unsuccessful there is no right of appeal.
