



### GCSE Drama Trip – *Blood Brothers*

12<sup>th</sup> September 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

Further to my previous letter, I am writing to inform you of the final arrangements for the GCSE Drama trip to see ***Blood Brothers*** at the **Wyvern Theatre, Swindon** on the evening of **Tuesday 21st October**.

You may remember that to keep transport costs down, we asked if you would be prepared to make your own transport arrangements to meet at the theatre and pick up after the performance.

**We will meet in front of the Wyvern theatre at 7.00pm. Pick up time will be 10.15pm.**

If it is not possible for you to make your own transport arrangements or car-share, a minibus will be available to pick-up and drop-off students at school. There will be an additional cost for this. You will be able to book a place on the minibus once final numbers are confirmed.

Students travelling by minibus should meet outside Student Services at 6.00pm. Pick up time from Farmor's School will be 11.00pm. Students do not need to wear school uniform. They may bring money for a programme or refreshments if they would like, but it is not necessary.

This trip is necessary for a key assessment on the GCSE Drama course. We are requesting a voluntary contribution of **£37.50** per person to cover the cost of the ticket. Should insufficient contributions be made then the visit will not be able to proceed.

Farmor's School believes that all students should have equal opportunity to benefit from school activities independent of their parents' financial means. To confirm your child's place to go on the trip, please sign up on ParentPay. The cut-off date for responses is **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> September**. All payments are non-refundable once your child has been allocated a place. If the trip is cancelled due to insufficient contributions, or other reasons, then your payment will be returned, less the transactional charges associated with the processing of payment.

We reserve the right to withdraw your child from this trip for poor behaviour in school that may present as a risk for those on the trip. Any student who is poorly behaved on the trip risks being banned from future trips.
