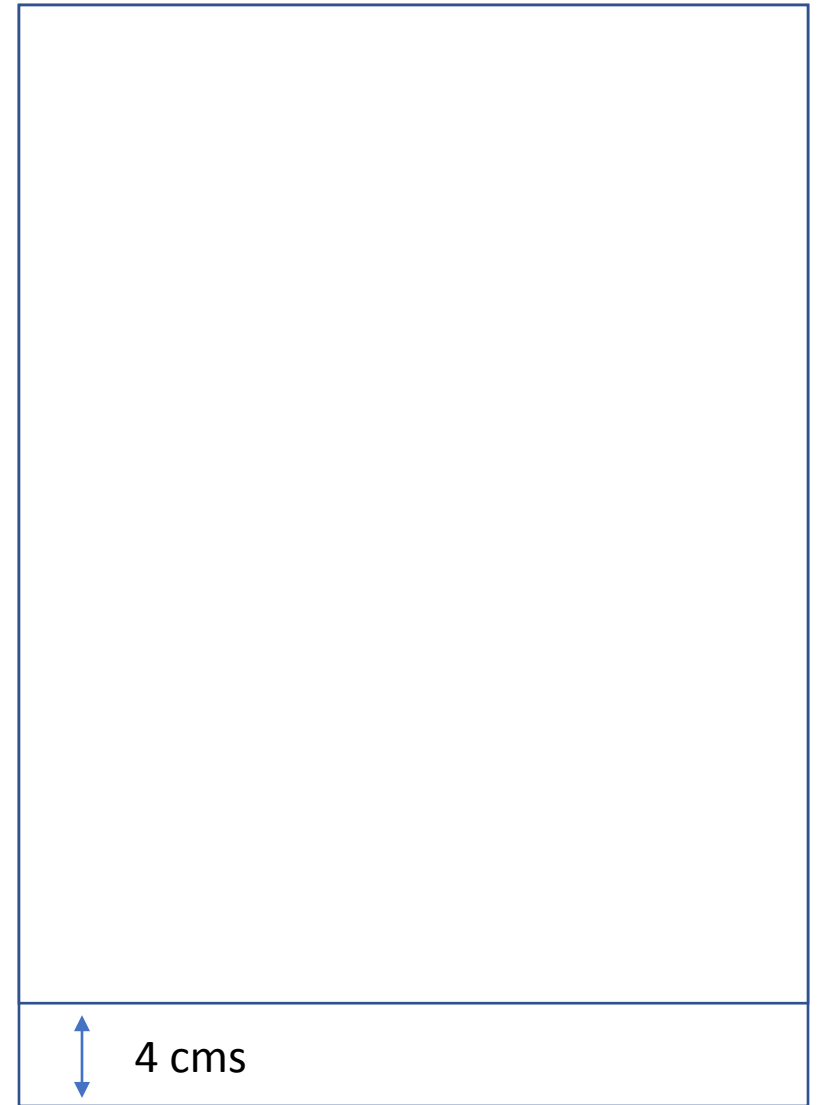

Choose your favourite pair of shoes and create an accurate observational study of them. Begin with a line drawing and then add tonal shading.

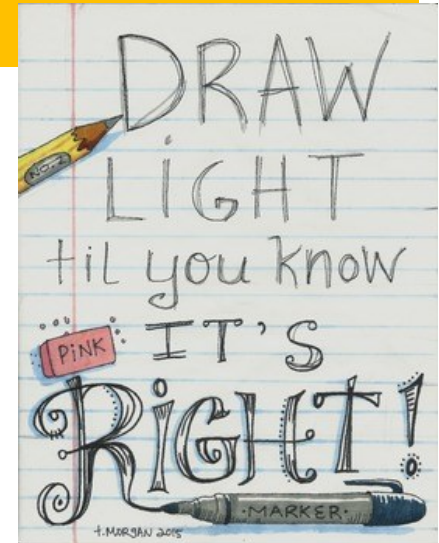
Helping hand- draw your shoe side on.

Top tips

- Roughly draw out your picture very lightly to start
- Then firm up your lines and rub out any lines you do not need.
