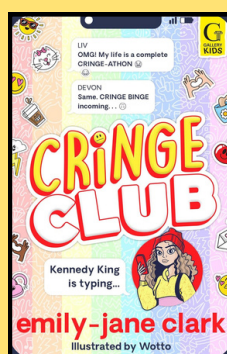
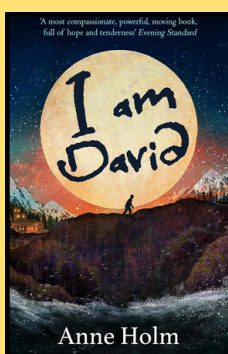
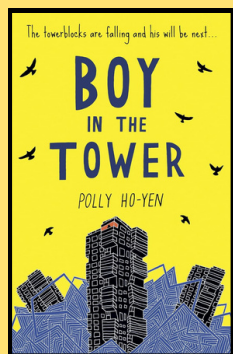
# THE LIBRARY

## Holocaust Memorial Day

Thank you to everyone who came to watch the event with Tom Palmer in conversation with Ruth Barnett. Ruth is a holocaust survivor who was rescued from Nazi Germany and brought to Britain through Kindertransport. Ruth showed great compassion towards people who had been cruel to her, one school asked her how she was able to show such compassion and Ruth explained that "we all have the possibility in us to be cruel, we all have the possibility in us to be kind". And she explained she felt it was her duty to speak to people about her experiences "because wars happen because people allow it" and that "horrors must be stopped before they become unstoppable."
