HAPPY JOLABOKAFLOD!

Jolabokaflod, which translates to Yule-book-flood, is the Icelandic tradition of giving and receiving books on Christmas eve.

This tradition began during World War II once Iceland had gained its independence from Denmark in 1944. Paper was one of the few commodities not rationed during the war, so Icelanders shared their love of books even more as other types of gifts were short supply. This increase in giving books as presents reinforced Iceland's culture as a nation of bookaholics.

Book gifts are opened on Christmas eve and they are read immediately, snuggled up with chocolates, hot chocolate or non alcoholic ale.

The library will be hosting its own Jolabokaflod from Friday the 12th of December, pick up a wrapped book from the library which you can borrow, unwrap and read on Christmas eve!
