Dear Parents, Guardians & Students,

As a reward for being part of our GCSE Music, and Drama courses as well as having shown interest in the Performing Arts both in and out of school, we will be taking a group of students to watch Mrs Doubtfire in the Shaftesbury Theatre, London. We will be leaving school by coach on Wednesday 29th January at 4:30pm and returning at about 1:00am on Thursday 30th January. You will have to make arrangements to transport your child home from school at this time.

Students will need to wear school uniform for the normal school day, they will then be able to get changed after school before getting on the coach. They should bring a packed tea and any spending money brought is at your own risk.

As this trip is not an essential part of the curriculum, we are requesting a contribution of £40.00 to cover the cost of transport and ticket. Should insufficient contributions be made then the visit may not be able to proceed. We have 50 tickets available for this trip and they will be offered initially to current GCSE Music and Drama students as of September 2024.
