Farmor's Tracksuit

Prior to COVID-19, we offered a "Team Farmors" Tracksuit option which was for those students to purchase if they were regular members of our school sports teams. When we ordinarily play fixtures, students often change into PE Kit during the school day so we arrive ready for fixtures. The tracksuit helps students stay smart and warm during the day as well as unstill the sense of pride in representing the school.

During COVID-19, students have had to wear their PE kit to school on PE days and, of course, the majority of this time has been during winter months. Since the students wear shorts/skorts for most of the PE, we allowed students to wear appropriate navy/black leggings or tracksuit bottoms. Hoodies, other colour bottoms or items plastered with logos are not permitted. To support this, we sourced a Farmor's Tracksuit which is worn as the top layer as a uniform item on PE days. Several students have bought these and they look very smart. It is important to stress that these **are not compulsory**. It may also be that we revert to wearing uniform to school on PE days by September and that students change into kit as normal, therefore removing the need for the tracksuit as a uniform item. The tracksuit top will remain an optional item in PE lessons (Tracksuit bottoms are not worn in PE) and they will be incredibly useful if your child is likely to play in our school teams.
