All years: Gloucestershire Initial Teacher Education Partnership (GITEP) SCITT is a highly successful school-centred initial teacher training provider, recognised as outstanding by Ofsted. The partnership has been created by Gloucestershire's secondary school leaders to ensure the highest quality of teaching for pupils in Gloucestershire schools.

School-centred means that trainees spend most of their time in schools,

including ours, learning from experienced and highly skilled teachers. Although the programme is predominantly school-based, trainees work towards a PGCE (Post Graduate Certificate in Education) worth 60 Masters credits, which is awarded by the University of Bristol.

GITEP's employment rates are close to 100% and many former trainees now play a significant role in the Gloucestershire's schools. If you or someone you know is considering a career in teaching, please consider sharing details of GITEP's Primary and Secondary teacher training courses.
