Notices:

- All years early finish: School will finish at 2.25 on the last day of this term, Friday 22nd March. All buses, apart from the service buses, will leave the school site at 2.35.
- All parents dropping off students: We have had two near misses around the roundabout at the end of the school day in recent weeks. A reminder that all students who travel to and from school by car should be dropped off and picked up from the Fairford car park near the church, at the end of the Ernest Cook Drive. There are medical exceptions to this, with permission from your child's head of year.
