#### **Strep A Virus**

You may have heard news reports about the Strep A virus. This virus is common and results in mild or no symptoms in most people who carry it. However, there have been a small number of fatalities in young children across England.

We are awaiting Government guidance about the virus, but in the meantime are advised to follow guidance relating to scarlet fever, which is caused by the Strep A virus. If the school has two or more confirmed cases of Strep A within a year group within a 10-day period, then we will inform the Health Protection Agency (HPA) and act of their advice.

Should we have an outbreak of Strep A at the school we would let parents know.

Please notify the school by leaving a message on the absence line if:

- Your child has a confirmed case of Strep A i.e. has received a positive result from a test carried out by a GP.
- Your GP has carried out a test on your child, but you have not yet received a result.

You do not need to let us know if other members of the family have tested positive for Strep A or if your child has symptoms like a sore throat.
