- Years 7-9 Lateral Flow Test bookings: Priority has been given to years 10-13 as they return to school the day before years 7-9. Bookings for students in years 7-9 will open on the parents evening booking system on **Tuesday** morning. A letter will be sent via in touch on Tuesday morning with further details.
- Year 7: Due to the return to school lateral flow tests, we have had to move next week's planned Parent's Evenings back by 2 weeks; these will now take place on Thursday 18th and Tuesday 23rd March. The booking system https://farmors1.schoolcloud.co.uk will go live on Tuesday 2nd March for parents to make appointments. Effective communication – presented and communicated in an engaging way.
