- Year 7: Many thanks to the 111 parents that completed the new starters' survey. This was a very positive survey and included 97% of parents feeling their child is supported well, 97% saying the school is well led and managed, 98% of parents who would recommend Farmor's to another parent and 99% of parents satisfied with their choice. Amongst positive comments in the written text responses, there were some individual concerns for us to look into, and two areas raised by more than one parent: new starter communication at the start of September, and for sporting fixtures; and canteen food /allergens /queuing. Work is ongoing to improve in these areas, thank you for raising these concerns.
- Years 7-9: Nasal Flu (first week in January) vaccination consent/decline paperwork were given to your son/daughter this week, please return the forms to student services.
- Y10 work experience 2023: The programme was launched in assembly this week, and students have been given a booklet to them through the process. There is a form for them to collect information from their prospective employer and students have been asked to fill in an online form to share this information with the school.
