- All years: Last term, the eco club (Environ) were successful in securing funding from Fairford Town Council to support a project to create a 'living willow' structure on the school site. The money will go towards materials and the training of Farmor's students into the rural craft of live willow weaving. On the 6th February, members of the school Environ will set to work on this exciting project. The result of this will be a 3m diameter, 2m high willow 'tepee' that will help support increased biodiversity and also promote rural skills.
