All years – Head Teacher Appointment: Dear Parents/Carers, I am delighted to inform you that after a robust and rigorous recruitment process, the Governing Board have appointed Mark Surowiec as the Headteacher of Farmor's School from 1st September 2025. All years - School day timings September 2025: Further to the consultation carried our earlier this year, the governing board have set the school day timings for the 2025/26 academic year as follows: The school day starts each day at 8.45am

All years - Read2Learn, Sociology: In Sociology we encourage students to read widely. Sociology is all around us - so we use current news articles, blogs, novels and textbooks to help students apply their classroom learning to the wider world. This widens and deepens their understanding and helps them to get excited about sociology! We teach students to read for meaning like a sociologist. They need to read with a critical eye and to be able to identify different sociological perspectives within a text. We also encourage them, as they read, to think about what makes good sociological writing. We teach them to identify how the author shows analysis of an idea or evaluation. This in turn can improve their own writing and exam technique.

All years – Laptops required: The Learning Support department are in need of laptops as our stock is ageing and slow! If you have any useable laptops gathering dust at home, could you please consider sending them in for us to repurpose and support our learners?
