Following the Christmas holiday, the government are encouraging schools to offer Covid tests to all pupils in school before term starts. These will take place on the Inset day, Tuesday 4th January, between 9.30am and 4pm. To book a slot, use this <u>link</u> and choose a 3 minute appointment with your child's head of year.

Bookings open at 10am on Monday and will close at lunch time on the last day of term (Friday 17th)

Notices:

- All years: Gloucestershire County Council's 'no child goes hungry' scheme is providing vouchers to parents who
 have previously signed up to their Holiday Free School Meals (FSM) scheme, funded through COVID-19 grant
 funding. New parents are encouraged to sign up as soon as they can before Monday 13 December. Voucher
 emails for £30 will be sent out between 13 and 15 December. If you apply after the deadline, they cannot
 guarantee delivery of vouchers before 25 December.
- All years: A reminder that we finish early on Friday 17th December. School finishes at 1.30 and buses leave at 1.40. Students who use the #77 to Cirencester (but not Quennington) will be able to leave at lunch to catch the earlier 12.50 bus from the Market Square. If your child catches the #76 or #855 and you wish for them to stay in school until the 3.30 bus arrives, please contact student services ghartshorn@farmors.gloucs.sch.uk
- All years: Christmas Jumper Day: Friday 10th December to raise money for <u>Save the Children</u> Students should bring in a £1 donation and can wear Christmas themed clothes.
- All years: Reminder to register on parentpay for up to four tickets for the Christmas Concert on 15th December.
- All years: All visitors to school must wear a mask, including those attending evening events, such as the carol concert or Matilda performances.
- All years, uniform reminder: please ensure your child leaves the house with the correct uniform, so the start of
 their school day does not involve conflict with their tutor. Masks must be worn on all buses and for most of the
 time in school (apart from in lessons, in outside year group zones and when eating in the canteen areas).
 The following are not allowed under our uniform policy:
 - Hoodies. Students should wear a coat over their blazer or jumper in cold weather
 - **Ear rings.** One plain stud or sleeper in each ear is allowed, however these must be removed for PE, so no new piercings until the summer holidays please.
 - Coloured Nail varnish
