Safeguarding Alert - WhatsApp: The following link is a timely reminder about privacy settings: Hundreds of children added to 'inappropriate' Whatsapp chat - BBC News

Parents and carers have been advised, to talk to children about the dangers of being added into unknown chats and to "block, delete and report groups of this nature immediately".
