University Admission Tests (October and November 2022)

Farmor's is an Oxbridge Test Centre and can enter you for the following admissions tests.

BMAT: BioMedical Admissions Test (for applicants to Medicine, Biomedical Science and Dentistry courses at certain Universities). This will be a computer based test. Please note that we are not a test centre for **UCAT** for Medicine. You must enter yourself for this test and complete it at home or at a Pearson test centre. CAT: Classics Admissions Test (for applicants to degree courses in Classics and its joint schools at the University of Oxford).

Cambridge pre-interview assessments: Pre-interview assessments, for undergraduate entry for some courses at University of Cambridge. To include ECAA (Economics), ENGAA (Engineering) and NSAA (Natural Sciences). More information can be found here: <u>Cambridge pre-interview assessments</u>

ELAT: English Literature Admissions Test (applying to study English at the University of Oxford and Cambridge). It is one of the elements admissions tutors use to decide whether to invite you for interview.

HAT: History Aptitude Test (for applicants studying undergraduate degree courses in History and its joint schools at the University of Oxford).

MAT: Mathematics Admissions Test (candidates applying to study undergraduate degree courses in Mathematics, Computer Science and their joint degrees at the University of Oxford). Also used by Imperial College London and University of Warwick.

Test of Mathematics: If you are applying to study Mathematics courses, a number of Universities accept this test. In most cases, the test is not compulsory; however, a good performance on this test may result in a reduced offer. Please visit the Universities' websites for more information. This will be a computer based test. Please note the earlier entry deadline. It is a requirement for Computer Science at Cambridge.

MLAT: Modern Languages Admissions Tests (applying to study undergraduate degree courses in Modern Languages, Linguistics and their joint degrees at the University of Oxford).

PAT: Physics Aptitude Test (required for all University of Oxford Engineering, Materials Science and Physics undergraduate degree courses). Calculators are permitted.

TSA: Thinking Skills Assessment: To help tutors assess whether candidates have the skills and aptitudes needed to study certain courses. Different TSA versions available for Cambridge, Oxford and UCL. More information can be found here:

Philosophy: admissions test for applicants to the joint course of Philosophy and Theology at the University of Oxford.

STEP: (Sixth Term Examination Paper) A well-established examination designed to test candidates on questions that are similar in style to undergraduate mathematics. STEP is used by the University, Warwick and Imperial College London as the basis for conditional offers. Other Universities sometimes ask candidates to take STEP as part of their offer – in such cases, the university can advise on which papers to take. There is a charge per paper. Costs tbc but should be around £60.

OLAT: Oriental Languages Aptitude Test (applying to study undergraduate degree courses in Oriental Studies and its joint schools at the University of Oxford).




