Dear Parents & Guardians,

Your son or daughter is studying GCSE English Literature. They will be following the AQA specification which requires the study of:

- 1 play by Shakespeare (either Macbeth or The Merchant of Venice)
- 1 'modern' text (either 'An Inspector Calls' or 'Lord of the Flies')
- 1 C19th novel (either 'A Christmas Carol' or 'Jekyll and Hyde.')
- An anthology of poetry (Anthology will be provided free of charge by AQA)

Ideally students will have their own personal copy of the text which they can make notes in and use for revision in Year 11. It is also helpful if all students have the same edition so that it is easier to follow in class. We therefore buy in copies of the text, taking advantage of bulk school discounts.

In the Autumn term they will be studying the modern text – either 'An Inspector Calls' or 'Lord of the Flies'. If you would like your son or daughter to have their own copy, please could you make a payment of £9 via Parentpay. It will show on your child's account as **'GCSE English Literature- modern text.'**

Your child's teacher will issue the book if payment has been received. If we do not receive payment, your child will either be issued with a photocopy or a used copy of the text (which will need to be returned to us after the exams in Year 11).
