Dear Parents of Students in Years 9,

The recent letter sent from Miss Craig, about the Camps International trip to Costa Rica, outlined an exciting opportunity for Farmor's students. I recognise that this is an expensive trip, and whilst the students are encouraged to raise all of the costs themselves, I expect that parents will end up contributing a proportion of that money.

There will be other expensive trips available to your child in the next two years, I am writing to give you some idea of what is in the pipeline so you are able to make an informed decision and/or budget accordingly. Financial support will only be available, on application, for the DofE award.
